testing after fasting overnight.

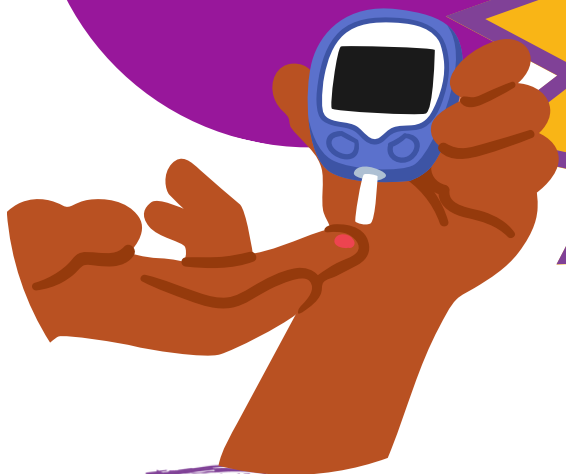
